


Search Marking Practice

<p>Scenario 1: Earthquake (~5.4 on Richter Scale) Evergreen Hill CERT Team hears sounds of distress from Kingsgate Library. Building size-up indicates minor structural damage. Interior has sustained some damage, mostly toppled bookcases and shattered glass. CERT team enters the library at 2:53pm and finds eight people. Six people are unharmed; they leave of their own free will. One person yells for help - a large bookcase has fallen on a librarian and her coworker has stayed with her. CERTS lift the bookcase off, but decide not to move the victim because of her injuries. The unharmed coworker who yelled for help refuses to leave her side. The CERT team decides to leave the building to find medical assistance at 3:48pm.</p>	
<p>Scenario 2: Winter Storm Kirkland gets 8 inches of snow in the last 24 hours. The roads are not passable and power outages are a possibility. Finn Hill CERT team goes out to check on neighbors. A large tree has fallen on one side of the house. The CERTs can hear moaning and decide the structure is stable enough for a quick search. They enter the home at 10:07am. The homeowner reports he was struck in the shoulder by a tree limb and lives alone. No visible broken bones, but he is in a lot of pain. Since his house is compromised, the CERTs decide to help him go to a neighbor's house, leaving at 10:32am. The neighbor will monitor him until Emergency Medical Services can get there.</p>
